<sup>\*</sup> Shoes must be plain, smart and business like; They must not look like a trainer. The shoes should not be suede, patent, have any coloured stitching or have any embellishments. The Academy has the final decision on whether a shoe is in line with the policy.

<sup>\*\*</sup>These items are optional, the only hat and scarf which students are permitted to wear must be the correct uniform items purchased from the uniform shop. Gloves must be plain black with no logos.

## Additional Items and Issues

- Students must wear correct uniform on the way to and from the Academy.
- If for religious or cultural reasons a student has to wear a head-covering then this must be a Mossbourne head scarf which is available from Trutex. Students' faces must always be fully visible. We do not allow full or partial face covering.
- Uniform exceptions may be made by the Principal but only where this is required as a matter of sincere religious observance. The Principal's decision is final.
- Girls may wear skirts or trousers but not both. Academy skirts may be worn in two lengths,
  i.e. knee length or mid-calf length. Skirts must not be shortened or lengthened beyond
  these limitations.
- Shirts and ties should be worn appropriately, i.e. shirts must be tucked in and collars buttoned and ties worn neither too long nor too short.
- Outdoor coats must be the Academy uniform coat.
- Coats must be removed upon entering the building.
- The Academy woollen hat, Academy scarf and gloves may be worn in the winter months only.
- Never wear trainers other than for PE or playing in the playground.
- No jewellery to be worn, except for a single/pair of small plain gold or silver stud earrings in the lobe of the ear, no diamantes. No other form of body piercing is allowed.
- A watch may be worn providing its only function/feature is telling the time e.g. no smartwatches, watches with alarms or sound effects, watches with calculators or video/audio recording capability.
- Jewellery and watches must be removed before all P.E. lessons.
- No make-up or nail varnish may be worn. Lip balm can be used but must not alter the natural appearance of the lips and must never be applied during lessons.
- There must be no hair/eyebrow markings.
- Facial hair should be neat and must not be styled.
- There must be no significant shaping of the hair/eyebrows; it should look natural. The
  Academy has the final decision on what constitutes significant. If in doubt do not shape the
  hair at all.
- High fashion styles are not permitted. The Academy has the final decision on what constitutes a high fashion style
- The difference in length between the top, the sides and the back of the hair must not be in sharp contrast.
- No topknots, beehives or side ponytails allowed.
- If longer than the top of the collar, hair must be tied back as one unit in a ponytail (which can be plaited), with a plain black hair band or simple black hair grips.
- Hair must always be kept off of the face and not fall over the eyes.
- · Hair bands must not be worn on the wrist.
- Indeed, hair must not be untidy in any way. It must be business-like and smart and worn in
  a plain style, which does not draw attention or is incongruous with the Academy uniform. If
  you have a doubt as to a style's acceptability, then the style is probably not acceptable.
- The Academy's decision about what is acceptable is final.
